

Ontario Rules of Civil Procedure, excepts from Rule 30:

## DISCOVERY OF DOCUMENTS RULE 30

### INTERPRETATION

**30.01** (1) In rules 30.02 to 30.11,

(a) “document” includes a sound recording, videotape, film, photograph, chart, graph, map, plan, survey, book of account, and data and information in electronic form;...

### SCOPE OF DOCUMENTARY DISCOVERY

#### Disclosure

**30.02** (1) Every document relating to any matter in issue in an action that is or has been in the possession, control or power of a party to the action shall be disclosed as provided in rules 30.03 to 30.10, whether or not privilege is claimed in respect of the document.

#### Production for Inspection

**30.02** (2) Every document relating to any matter in issue in an action that is in the possession, control or power of a party to the action shall be produced for inspection if requested, as provided in rules 30.03 to 30.10, unless privilege is claimed in respect of the document.
